| <p>Where does the story take place? When did the story take place? What did the character look like? Where did the character live? What happened in the story? What kinds of people are in the story? Explain something that happened at a specific point in the story?</p> | <p>If you were going to interview this character/author, which questions would you ask? Which is your favourite part? Why? Who was the storyteller? How do you know? Predict what you think is going to happen next. Why do you think this? Who would you like to meet most in the story? Why? Is this a place you could visit? Why/why not? What do you think would happen next if the story carried on past the ending in the book? How is the main character feeling at the start/middle/end of the story? Why do they feel that way? Does this surprise you?</p> |
