Curriculum Subject	Suggested Learning Activities
Topic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Write a letter to someone in Japan telling them what Britain is like and what questions you have about Japan.</li><li>• Write a diary entry of an imaginary trip to Japan (or a real trip!).</li><li>• Have a go at making some origami and teaching someone else.</li><li>• Make a 3D map of Japan including physical and human features.</li><li>• Research the work of Katsushika Hokusai and paint a picture in the style of this artist.</li></ul>
STEM – Anatomy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Design and engineer a human skeleton and label the bones of the human body.</li><li>• Create and perform a song about the bones of the human body.</li><li>• Research the organs and explore the skeletons role in protecting them.</li><li>• Bake a healthy snack to encourage efficient digestion.</li><li>• Keep a food diary for a week to understand and analyse your eating habits.</li></ul>
PSHE & Values	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Take part in a democratic vote in your household for who should do the chores.</li><li>• Teach your household the three parts of the brain we have learnt about.</li><li>• Make a poster about the brain and what happens in certain situations.</li></ul>
P.E.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Create your own fitness circuit and try and teach someone else.</li><li>• Choreography your own Japanese dance (Think about the music and costumes).</li><li>• Record how you get to school every day for a week.</li></ul>
R.E	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Visit a church or synagogue to understand aspects of other religions.</li><li>• Interview someone from another religion to learn something new.</li><li>• Create your own ten commandments that you and everyone in your home can live by.</li></ul>
