



Curriculum Subject	Suggested Learning Activities
Topic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To create a map of human and physical features of Scotland • Research and make a poster all about Edinburgh • Sketch and create a tartan (try using a fabric) • Create a tourism brochure encouraging people to visit Scotland • Listen to the bagpipes – appraise a piece of bagpipe music (suggestions: Highland Cathedral, O'flower of Scotland)
STEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create a model to demonstrate how light/sound travels. • Investigate how a telescope works and see if you can make your own telescope at home • Investigate what light travels through and what blocks out light. • Make a poster explaining the dangers that sunlight may have on our eyes and our body • Draw a detailed diagram of our eyes, and research how they let light in • Find things in your house which make a noise. Can the noise get louder, can the noise get quieter? How does this happen?
PSHE & Values	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Research your local community by interviewing a few people. Record the questions and answers • Make a poster of how people live in 4 different countries • Take photos of you displaying the Bevington Values out in the public • Think about someone you have a positive relationship with – Make a spider diagram to show why it is positive
P.E.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Try and learn a Scottish country dance with your friends and family at home • Count how many times you and a partner can catch a ball without dropping it • Race your sibling/parent/carer to the park and record who the winners are – could you do this every day?
R.E	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visit three different places of worship from different religions – can you tell us what they were like • Make a poster explaining the different places that people worship and their names. • Can you build a 3D model of a place of worship of your choice – think carefully about what features to involve
