STEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Create a model to demonstrate how light travels.• Investigate how a telescope works and see if you can make your own telescope at home• Investigate what light travels through and what blocks out light.• Make a poster explaining the dangers that sunlight may have on our eyes and our body• Draw a detailed diagram of our eyes, and research how they let light in
